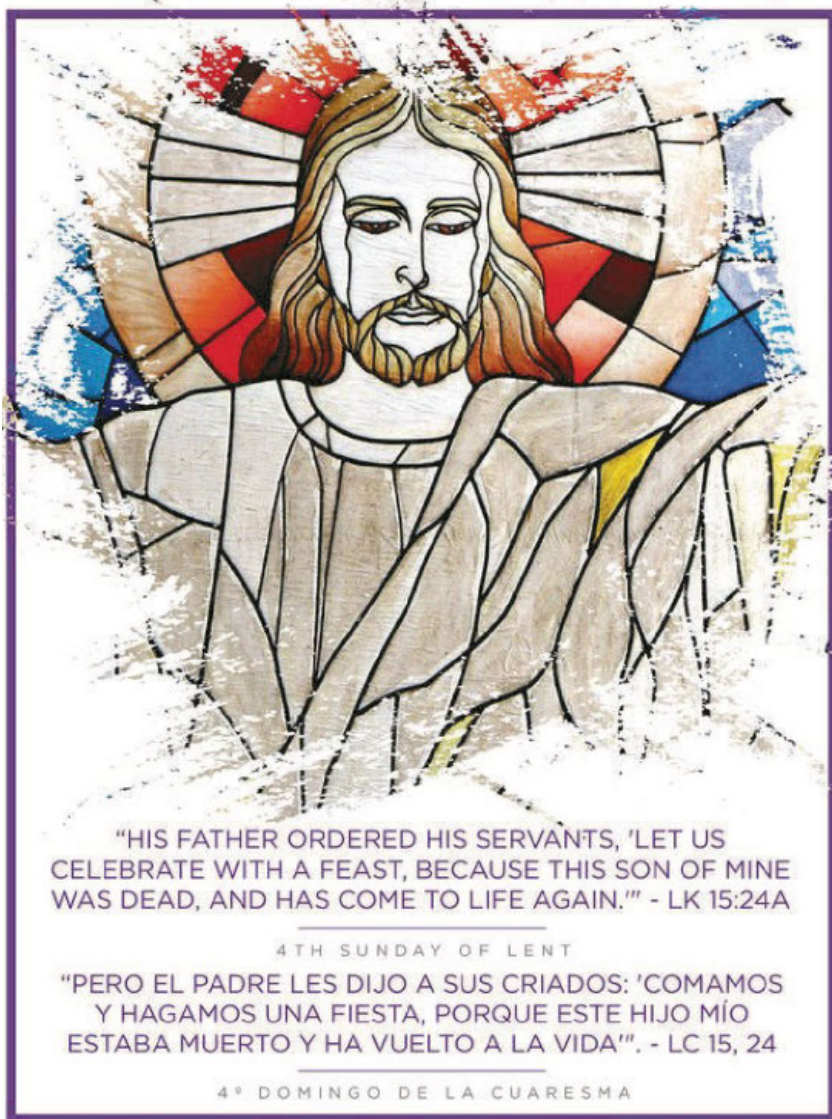

This Sunday our catechumens Oceanna, Claudia, Briana, Eyden and Ruben; together with all of us, share the Scrutinies once more. We will hear the Gospel story of the Man Born Blind. We are all invited to look deep in our hearts, confronting our sinfulness, our blindness. The Lord is so close to us, but we do not see or believe in his presence. The irony is that the man born blind "saw" the presence of Jesus in his blindness, even more than those who could physically "see." May we truly repent, apologizing for the ways we have hurt others and our world, and lavishing/receiving the forgiveness of Christ upon those most in need of God's mercy.

May the goal of our lives be heaven, yes, but to become like the one who is *in* heaven: Jesus, to call him by name and live in his peace this Season of Lent. Our project this Lent is to help the Catholic Relief Service give food and clothing to those affected by the war in the Ukraine. JESUS SANA A UN CIEGO DE NACIMIENTO. Reflexión Juan 9, 1-41

Hoy podemos ver como Jesús sana a otra persona y de otro problema, vemos como un ciego de nacimiento recobra la vista gracias al Señor Jesús y también a la fe que tenía el ciego. Después de eso comenzó a tener problemas con los fariseos y hasta fue expulsado de su congregación.



1. Glorificar el poder de Dios.

En los versículos 2 y 3 los discípulos le hacen una pregunta al Señor Jesús acerca del ciego, y se refieren de esta manera “Rabí, quién pecó, éste o sus padres para que haya nacido ciego”. Para los judíos que tenían como creencia que si alguien pasaba por calamidades o sufrimientos era resultado del pecado que había en esa persona o sus padres. Por eso los discípulos preguntaron a Jesús, pero Él le responde algo que quizás ni se imaginaron escuchar, Jesús les dice “no es que pecó éste, ni sus padres, sino que para que la obra de Dios se manifieste en él.

Jesús usó el sufrimiento de ésta persona para que el poder de Dios se pueda glorificar y también enseñar acerca de la fe. No siempre el sufrimiento y otras cosas son resultado del pecado, en muchos casos el poder de Dios debe conocerse en una persona, y tal persona debe glorificarle a Dios.

2. La incredulidad también nos deja ciegos.

Los fariseos comenzaron a cuestionar lo que Jesús estaba haciendo, mientras que ellos discutían por lo que Jesús hacía, muchas personas se sanaban y cambiaban, estos fariseos estaban celosos de que Jesús les estaba sacando su popularidad a ellos y no creían que Él era el Cristo y estaban ciegos espiritualmente.

Los fariseos tenían una lista larga de prohibiciones y permisos, y Jesús falló ante una de sus prohibiciones que era la de no hacer nada en el día de reposo. Él hace lodo y le pone en los ojos a ciego, eso implicaba ya un trabajo. No importa la hora ni el día, si en nuestras manos está servirle a nuestro prójimo de alguna manera, debemos hacer, no caer en esa ceguera espiritual en el cual cayeron los fariseos.

3. La fe es probada.

Este nuevo hombre en Cristo fue interrogado muchas veces, y hasta comenzó a enseñarles a los fariseos. La fe de este ex ciego estaba bien asentada y no le importaba lo que le dijeran o hicieran. Sus padres tuvieron temor de ser expulsados de la sinagoga y por lo tanto no accedían a responder las preguntas que le hacían a su hijo, directamente lo responsabilizaban a él.

Su fe fue probada severamente por las autoridades, lo maldijeron y echaron de la sinagoga. Al igual que nosotros muchos amigos y otras cosas podemos perder al tener esta fe en Jesucristo, pero lo que no vamos a perder es la vida eterna que ya tiene preparada para nosotros.

Cuanto más experimentaba, más confiaba este hombre en aquel que le sanó.

Conclusión: Hemos podido ver tres enseñanzas claras, pudimos comprender que el sufrimiento y las calamidades no siempre son el resultado de nuestros pecados, sino que para que el poder de Dios sea glorificado, también el no creer en Jesús puede dejarnos ciegos espiritualmente y que nuestra fe va seguir siendo probada siempre y cuando busquemos más y más de Nuestro Salvador que es Jesucristo.

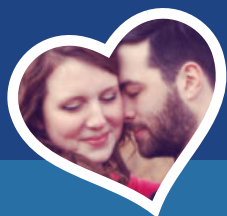
