

## Our Council Namesake!

Quite some time ago, one of our newer Brothers at the time asked "if there's room in the next mailer, could someone explain the history of the name of our council?". Let me begin by apologizing as many months have gone by since he asked. Not knowing the answer myself, I sent a request to a couple of our "seasoned Brothers" and want to share their responses. It is my understanding that Mr. Stephani owned a burial vault company and was a well resected Catholic gentleman in the community. Here what Ed Brey shared with me: "William Stephani passed in 1970 and left money to the council if named after him and his picture was to hang in the clubhouse for 40 years." Bob Becker shared this: "I went to school with his granddaughter, Mary Ellen. The Stephani's belonged to St. Andrew Parish for many years and had the "vault" business for final burial and it's still there on Viebahn Street. I wonder if he donated the property for the clubhouse?".
